

LMSTS 2nd ANNUAL WALK A THON
HALLOWEEN THEME WE WILL WALK THE NEIGHBOURHOOD IN COSTUMES!!!

As part of the physical education curriculum **all** students at LMSTS (whether or not they collect pledges) will be participating in a school walk a thon. **Students are welcome to wear costumes as long as they can walk with ease and visibility is good.**

Students are encouraged to collect sponsors to raise money for both our school and a charity selected by the Grade 6 Leadership Team.

All students who participate in the walk a thon AND RETURN THEIR PLEDGE SHEET, regardless of whether or not they have collected sponsor, will have their name entered in a prize draw. EACH SPONSOR (of \$1 or more) YOUR CHILD GETS, HE OR SHE WILL RECEIVE 1 ADDITIONAL TICKET FOR THE PRIZE DRAW.

During the walk a thon grade 6 students will be collecting food donations from homes on the route for the food bank. In advance of the walk-a-thon, we will be delivering notices to homes on our route requesting that they place non- perishable food items on their steps marked with LMST. However, students are encouraged to bring in a non perishable food item prior to the event.

WHO: All LMST Students

WHAT: LMST Walk-a-Thon

WHEN: Monday October 31

TIME: Start 1:15- Finish 2:15

WHERE: Around neighbourhood - route map attached – Our School Liaison Officer will be present at this activity.

WHY: To encourage physical activity as well as raise money for the school for various items on teacher wish lists not covered by our School Board Budget or our H&S Budget. For example furniture (kidney tables), balls use by student's at recess and lunch time, point 2 views for each classroom, and extra resource materials for teachers.

NOTE: **Because of safety issues, we do not encourage students to go door to door collecting sponsors for this event. Just collect from family and friends.**
